GED & CONSTRUCTION TRAINING PROGRAM

Are you interested in earning your GED and obtaining occupational skills training in the Construction field for free?



The Capitol Region Education Council offers a 25-week training program for qualified candidates who want to earn their GED and receive training in construction trades. Along with obtaining your GED, students will receive certifications in:

- **❖** OSHA-10
- * CPR & First Aid
- **❖** Fork Lift Operation

- ❖ Aerial Lift
- **❖** Blueprint Reading

The training program includes a 10-week, 150-hour, paid field placement at local area construction sites. Trainees will also be able to obtain a Connecticut Department of Motor Vehicles Driver's License. Job placement services are provided for all training program graduates.

Training Qualifications

- **❖** Ages 17-21
- ❖ Dedicated to obtaining your GED
- The desire, motivation, and commitment to working in the construction trade
- ❖ Must reside in Hartford County
- Must meet eligibility requirements under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) guidelines
